### Expressive Arts

- Make wall frieze depicting a scene from the poem or stories suggested. Put captions in Shetland dialect.
- Make the sounds of stormy weather using percussion instruments or find different ways of making sounds. Try to find descriptive dialect words to describe the sounds.

- Use the cards provided to help record the weather condition each day.
